Wentworth Point new high school

Works notification | 24 February 2023

Multiple overnight deliveries between 1 and 15 March 2023

As part of the construction of the lift shafts for the new Wentworth Point high school, a jump form formwork system will be required on site.

The majority of parts will arrive in deliveries during usual construction hours, but three deliveries of oversized equipment require delivery after hours to meet Transport for NSW requirements to keep the road network clear.

The deliveries are expected to occur between 1am to 5am on three separate nights between Wednesday 1 March and Tuesday 7 March 2023 weather permitting. In the event of delays caused by inclement weather, the deliveries will occur the following week between Wednesday 8 March and Tuesday 15 March 2023.

The parts will be delivered on a semi-trailer, travelling in and out from the construction site via Burroway Road and Hill Road.


Precautions will be in place to minimise noise, including avoiding reversing beeps where possible. Once the semi-trailers arrive, they will park on site until usual working hours start (7am to 5pm) to be unloaded, so no further noise will occur.

Temporary loss of parking spaces on Burroway Road from 13 to 27 March 2023

A Telstra box currently located on the footpath on Burroway Road needs to be removed as part of the construction of the new high school. These works will take place between 16 to 27 March 2023.

The majority of work will occur on the already closed footpath (see <u>Works notification 18 November 2022</u>) but will require the temporary closure of four parking spaces on Burroway Road from Monday 13 March to Monday 27 March 2023. See diagram below.
