

# Wentworth Point new high school

Works notification | 23 January 2023

## Temporary Burroway Road lane closure 30-31 January 2023

As part of the Wentworth Point new high school construction project, an existing power pole needs to be removed from site.


To complete this work, Ausgrid is required to close a 10 metre section of Burroway Road from 30-31 2023 January from 7 am to 5 pm. See map below.

Traffic control will be in place from 7 am to 5 pm during the works to manage the smooth flow of traffic on Burroway Road and Wentworth Place. Outside these hours the lane will be open for regular traffic flow.

The three parking spaces on Burroway Road next to the roundabout (see below) will be blocked for the two days of work to accommodate the placement of the crane truck.

This work will also cause a temporary power outage to the Wentworth Point new high school site and neighbouring site owned by Transport for NSW. The power outage will be from 9 am to 3 pm on 31 January 2023 and will not affect Wentworth Point Public School or any residential dwellings.
