Works notification | 22 May 2023

Temporary lane and footpath closures Burroway Road from 29 May to 12 June 2023

The next stage of works to deliver Wentworth Point new high school involves trenching for the installation of inground high voltage conduits that cross underneath Burroway Road.

The works are expected to take place during usual working hours, Monday to Friday between 7 am and 6 pm from Monday 29 May to Monday 12 June 2023.


To complete this work a section of Burroway Road will be impacted for up to two weeks. This includes impacts to pedestrian traffic, the temporary loss of 6 parking spaces and some lane closures. Details are outlined in the images below and on the next page.

The lane closures will occur in two stages to ensure vehicle access to Burroway Road remains open at all times. Work will start on the school side of Burroway Road and finish on the opposite side.

Traffic management will be in place to divert traffic safely around the road closures and existing pedestrian closures. This includes dedicated traffic controllers during work hours, signage and barriers around the work. At the end of each day, a footpath or temporary footpath will be reinstated for foot traffic until works start the following day.

There may be some additional noise created during this work, but live noise monitoring equipment will be in place to ensure works are within the allowable noise range.


