Works notification | 6 October 2023

After hours delivery of pile rig scheduled between 16 to 20 October 2023

A pile rig, used to drill holes for inserting the structural columns for the bike store and other external areas, will be delivered to site outside normal working hours to meet Transport for NSW requirements as an oversized delivery.

- The rig is expected to be delivered from 3am one weekday evening only between 16 October 2023 and 20 October 2023 dependent on weather and rig availability.
- The rig will be delivered on a semi-trailer travelling via Hill Road and Burroway Road to the construction site.
- Some noise may be created during the delivery, but all precautions to minimise noise will be taken, including avoiding reversing where possible.

The out of hours work is for the delivery only. Installation of the pile rig will take place during the usual weekday working hours of 7am to 6pm.

Weekend removal of tower crane 21 and 22 October 2023

In addition to the above, one of the two tower cranes on site is no longer needed and will be dismantled and removed on the weekend of Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 October 2023 between the hours of 8am and 4pm.

We have chosen to complete these works on the weekend to minimise the risk to site workers, who usually work Monday to Friday.

Traffic management will be in place for the entry and exit of the trucks required for the removal.

Should there be any delays due to inclement weather, the removal will take place on the following weekend, Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 October 2023.
