## Ongoing lane and roundabout impacts on Burroway Road from Monday 19 February 2024

The next stage of construction for the new high school in Wentworth Point is undertaking public domain works outside the school boundary. The first stage of these works involves, kerb re-alignment, paving and tree planting on approximately 90 metres of Burroway Road.

These works are expected to commence Monday 19 February 2024 and be ongoing until May 2024 during the usual construction hours, of 7am to 6pm.

The work will include temporary impacts to a section of Burroway Road, including changes to pedestrian access, partial road, roundabout and footpath closures and the temporary loss of 7 parking spaces. Please see the map below outlining the work area.


Throughout the work traffic management will be in place to ensure traffic is safely diverted around the road closures, roundabout, and to assist with pedestrian closures. This will include dedicated traffic controllers during work hours, and signage and barriers being installed around the work zone.

Stage two of these works will involve the construction of a pedestrian crossing across Burroway Road. We will advise the community when these works are due to commence, as they will require additional road closures.

Please be assured that access to Burroway Road and Wentworth Place will remain open at all times.

There may be some additional noise created by this work due to concrete cutting.

Drivers are encouraged to adhere to all traffic management and road signage for the safety of the community.
