Temporary lane and roundabout impacts on Burroway Road Thursday 25 January 2024

The next stage of the installation of the critical water and wastewater infrastructure for the new high school is the cleaning of the existing Sydney Water pressurised sewer line.

These works are expected to take place on Thursday 25 January 2024 during usual construction hours, between 7am and 6pm.

The work will include temporary impacts to a section of Burroway Road. This includes changes to pedestrian access, partial road, roundabout and footpath closures and the temporary loss of the two short term parking spaces alongside Wentworth Point Public School. At some times during the construction hours, drivers will not be able to do a u-turn on Wentworth Place. See the map below to see the work area.


After successful completion of these works, an overnight shift (6pm to 6am) is expected to be undertaken in conjunction with Sydney Water representatives to reconnect the sewer line in the following week. The work may be noisy and the above traffic conditions will be in place for the duration of the overnight works.

Work has been scheduled this week to reduce impact on the school community before school returns. Across the work area, traffic management will be in place to divert traffic safely around the road closures, roundabout and existing pedestrian closures. This includes dedicated traffic controllers during work hours, signage and barriers around the work.

Please be assured that access to Burroway Road and Wentworth Place will remain open at all times.

There may be some additional noise created by this work.

Drivers are encouraged to adhere to all traffic management and road signage for safety of the community.



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
