Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A new high school will open in 2025 to cater for the growing population in the Wentworth Point, Sydney Olympic Park, Newington, Silverwater and Rhodes communities. The school is located at 7 Burroway Road, Wentworth Point.

The completed high school will have new classrooms and learning spaces for approximately 1,500 students, as well as a multipurpose hall for sports and performance, outdoor spaces, including landscaped recreation areas, games courts and canteen facilities.

Expression of Interest Year 8 2024

Last month, the department undertook a survey to seek interest in enrolling Year 8 students at Wentworth Point High School from 2025. At that time there was insufficient interest to open a Year 8, 2025 intake because a small number of enrolments would limit curriculum offerings, particularly for elective subjects.
