Works notification | 27 June 2024

A project is underway to build a new high school in Wentworth Point.

Footpath closure on Burroway Road from 2-19 July 2024

The next step to completing the public domain works on Burroway Road is to connect the street lights and relocate some electrical pillars outside Wentworth Point High School.

To ensure the safety of the community and workers while these works are undertaken, a temporary footpath closure and electrical outages will be required.

The footpath closure (indicated in green on the image below) will remain in place for the duration of works from Tuesday 2 July to Friday 19 July, weather permitting.

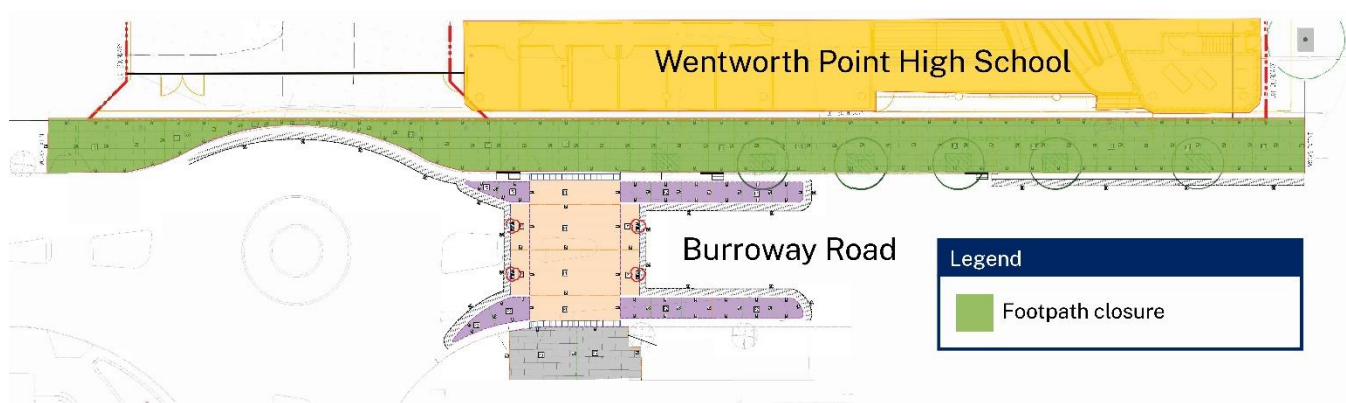
Fencing will be in place to restrict access and signage will be in place to direct pedestrians to the opposite side of the road for the duration of the closure.

Work hours will be Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm only for the duration of the work.

A temporary outage by Ausgrid during work hours will occur to allow for the relocation of electrical pillars and to connect the street lights. This outage will be localised to the high school site and immediate surrounds, and any affected neighbours or businesses will be notified.

There will be no impact on vehicle traffic during this work, but drivers are asked to drive safely and watch for pedestrians at all times.
