Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Wentworth Point Public School upgrade – Stage 2

Project overview

A project to upgrade Wentworth Point Public School is in planning. The upgrade will include additional modern, fit for purpose permanent teaching spaces to meet growing enrolment demand in the area. It is also anticipated that the library will be reconfigured to better suit the needs of the school, with open space also maximised and improved.

Progress update

- The business case has been submitted to NSW treasury for approval.
- A masterplan for the school upgrade has been developed and will be shared at an information session on Monday, 12 December 2022.
- Group GSA has been appointed as the architect for the project.

Next steps

- Ongoing development of the design in consultation with representatives from the Department of Education, Wentworth Point Public School, architects, planners and design professionals. This also includes reviewing the layout and design of the current 3 level library.
- An information session will be held on Monday, 12 December to view the masterplan for the school and learn more about the process to upgrade schools. Details are provided on the next page.

Wentworth Point new high school

Project overview

A new high school is being developed to cater for the growing population in the Wentworth Point, Sydney Olympic Park and Concord West communities. The school will be located on a part of 7 Burroway Road, Wentworth Point.

The completed high school will have flexible teaching and learning spaces for approximately 1,500 students as well as a multipurpose hall for sports and performance, outdoor spaces including landscaped recreation areas, games courts and canteen facilities.

Progress update

- Construction started on 31 October 2022 with site establishment and remediation work. This includes the construction of the main driveway on to the site through the roundabout at Burroway Road and Wentworth Place.
- Landcom submitted an application to City of Parramatta to modify an existing development approval to relocate a road from its current approved location to the east of the school, and to identify the location of the future playing field. This was on public exhibition until 2 December 2022.

Next steps

- Construction continues with a piling rig being delivered between 7-9 December. A pile rig is required on site to prepare the foundation of the building. For Wentworth Point new high school, a displacement piling rig will be used to install the concrete piles to a depth of 12 metres.
- Following the approval of Landcom's modification by City of Parramatta, we will submit an application to commence phase 2 works (previously explained in [June FAQs](#) and [June Information boards](#), available on our website edu.nsw.link/WPNHS).
- Formal school naming process.
- Construction timeline to be finalised.
