Wentworth Point Public School upgrade – Stage 2

Project overview

A project to upgrade Wentworth Point Public School is in planning. The upgrade will include additional modern, fit-for-purpose permanent teaching spaces to meet the growing enrolment demand in the area. The library will be reconfigured to better suit the needs of the school, with open space maximised, and the temporary demountable buildings will be removed.

Progress update

- The business case has been approved by NSW Treasury. This means the funds have been released to complete the project.
- The concept designs for the upgrade are in progress and will be finalised ahead of the submission of the Development Application.

Next steps

- A Development Application (DA) will soon be submitted to City of Parramatta Council for approval. Following the submission, the DA will be placed on exhibition by Council. We will update the community when this happens.
- An information session will be held on Wednesday 26 July 2023, where the community will be able to view plans for the upgrade and ask any questions about the project and the Development Application.

Wentworth Point new high school

Project overview

A new high school is being developed to cater for the growing population in the Wentworth Point, Sydney Olympic Park and Concord West communities. The school will be located on 7 Burroway Road, Wentworth Point. The completed high school will have flexible teaching and learning spaces for approximately 1,500 students as well as a multipurpose hall for sports and performance, outdoor spaces including landscaped recreation areas, games courts and canteen facilities.

Progress update

- Piling works to prepare the foundations of the buildings are complete. This included bulk excavation, installation of retaining walls, lift and drainage pits.
- Both cranes have arrived on site and the first concrete slab for the main building has been poured.
- Trenching and potholing works in Burroway Road for in-ground services has occurred.

Next steps

- Pouring of the remaining ground floor concrete slabs followed by the slabs for levels 1 to 6 of the new buildings.
- Power and water services including sewerage systems to be installed.

Frequently asked questions

When will the school open and how can I enrol?

The school is expected to open for Day 1 Term 1 in 2025 for Year 7 only. A new cohort of Year 7 students will commence each year thereafter. Enrolments will begin once a principal for the school has been announced, and are anticipated to commence in early 2024.

What will the intake area be for the new high school?

The intake area will be confirmed closer to the school opening. Changes to surrounding intake areas are generally made to accommodate a new school in a local network and this typically takes place around 12 months before the new school opens. This ensures the community is well informed in advance of enrolment periods and the school can prepare for anticipated student numbers.

Will construction of the two schools be happening at the same time?

Construction of the high school started in October 2022 and is expected to be complete by late 2024. This is subject to the outcome of further planning approvals. The timeline for the completion of the Wentworth Point Public School will be determined after the Development Application is approved and a contractor is appointed.
