Wentworth Point Public School Works notification | 15 November 2023

Installation of temporary classrooms from Thursday 16 November 2023

Due to unexpected enrolment demand at Wentworth Point Public School, two additional demountable classrooms are being installed on site in the coming weeks to cater for the demand in 2024, as shown on the map below.


On Thursday 16 and Friday 17 November temporary safety fencing will be installed on site. On Saturday 18 November concrete will be poured for the structural pylons between the hours of 8 am and 1pm.

Concrete trucks will access the school from Burroway Road, with hoses travelling along the fence line. Some noise is anticipated during these works.

Works will not impact the flow of traffic on Burroway Road, but access to the two parking spaces outside the school will be temporarily restricted during the concrete pour.

The new demountable classrooms will be delivered in coming weeks on cranes via the high school site. We will provide more information before this work occurs.

Safety fencing will remain until the installation of the demountable classrooms is complete to ensure the safety of staff and students. School supervision will also be in place. We thank you for your patience as we deliver this important school infrastructure.
