Concrete pour update

As per the <u>works notification distributed on Thursday 3 July 2025</u>, we are preparing for further concrete pours for the new Building D. Due to recent inclement weather, the building's second-floor slab will now be poured over two days on Tuesday 8 July 2025 and Thursday 10 July 2025, weather permitting.

- Traffic controllers will be onsite during work hours to assist with pedestrian safety.
- We will take every effort to minimise noise during the pours, including reducing the time that trucks are stationary.
- Increased truck movements are expected in the area between 7 am and 5 pm.

Should weather impact these works, they will take place on the next available dry day.
