Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to redevelop the former Marsden High School site on Winbourne Street to create a new community multi-sports facility with a focus on one of NSW's highest participation sports, netball.

The project will deliver 33 new sports courts including a new building with 4 indoor multipurpose courts and 29 outdoor netball courts. In addition, the project will include a C2 ecological zone to protect land of high environmental value and significance, landscaping with open lawns, seating and picnic tables, and parking facilities for bicycles and cars.

We will continue to collaborate with local government regarding any further traffic improvements that can be considered as the project progresses.

Progress summary

Works are well underway. The first concrete pour of the basement is now finished and the installation of the structural steel walls for the main structure has started.

Next steps

- Continue structural steel works.
- Continue with remainder of concrete pours.
- Stormwater installation to external courts.
- Inground services.
