West Ryde Public School Project update

West Ryde Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade West Ryde Public School. The project will provide new facilities for students and staff. Once completed in mid 2020, the project will deliver:

- a new three-storey building
- new innovative learning environments
- 14 permanent teaching spaces
- upgrades to core facilities
- a new library
- more functional open outdoor play space.

Progress summary

Students and staff moved in to their temporary facilities in Term 4 2018.

Site establishment prepares the construction area so that works can begin. As part of the site establishment, the contractor will:

- erect construction fencing
- install the site office and work sheds
- deliver equipment
- create a dedicated entrance to the construction site from Endeavour Street.

Main construction works are scheduled to begin from March 2019.

What to expect

Throughout the construction period, efforts will be put in place to mitigate impacts to staff, students and the community.

Contractor deliveries will be scheduled to minimise impacts to the existing 'kiss and drop' area.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday and Saturdays during approved hours. We will continue to update the community as the works progress.
