Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

West Ryde Public School

A project is underway to upgrade West Ryde Public School. The project will provide a new three storey building with 14 modern learning spaces and a new library. There will also be an upgrade to core facilities with expected completion in mid 2020.

Progress summary

The design for the upgrade is nearing completion. The existing temporary school facilities have been relocated on site to provide access to the construction site.

Main construction works are planned to start in early 2019.

Next steps

Site establishment will take place in early 2019 and will prepare the work area so that construction works can begin.

As part of the site establishment, the contractor will:

- install contractor site signage and fencing
- establish dedicated construction entry points.

Construction vehicle movements and deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak school pickup and drop-off times wherever possible. Site establishment and construction work will take place during approved hours.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and to minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
