

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

West Ryde Public School upgrade

An upgrade is underway for West Ryde Public School which will provide futurefocused permanent learning spaces, upgraded core facilities and improved playing areas.

Project summary

The concept design is nearing completion and the business case has been submitted for approval.

Enabling works have now commenced on site with main construction works to commence early 2019. The completion of the upgrade is due mid 2020.

Next steps

School Infrastructure NSW will continue to work closely with the school community and share regular updates as the project progresses.
