

Stage 2 (Underway)

Stage 2 of the project is underway for improved play areas and upgrades to core facilities.

Innovative learning environments


The new building at West Ryde Public School is now ready for students and staff to use when school operations return to normal.

Frequently asked questions

What has the upgrade at West Ryde Public School delivered?

The West Ryde Public School upgrade is being progressively delivered.

Stage 1 of the project has been completed, which includes the new three storey building with 14 permanent learning spaces. The new building and our new library and associated facilities are ready to be used by students and staff.

Which classes have been relocated to the new building?

In 2020, Years 2, 3, 4 and 1/2SH will occupy the new learning spaces. All students will experience the new learning spaces within the library.

Will there be any changes to the school entrance?

In this phase, the school office will be in the same building, but will be relocated closer to the new building (Block I) and a new entrance will be opened to parents and students on Endeavour Street (please see School plan overleaf for details).

Will there be any changes to parking, staff parking or the bus stop?

During the refurbishment of the administration building (Block A), the Endeavour Street carpark will be shut. Buses will continue to pick up students as per normal.

Will there be any changes to the Out of School Hours Care?

No, the Out of School Hours Care will continue to run as per normal.

What construction work will take place in 2020?

Stage 2 works have commenced and will continue throughout Term 2. These works include the refurbishment of the existing ground floor administration building (Block A), improvements to the play area, landscaping as well as removal of the demountables.

When will the project be completed?

The West Ryde Public School upgrade is expected to be completed by the end of August 2020.
