

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

West Ryde Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade West Ryde Public School. The project will provide new facilities for students and staff. Once completed in mid-2020, the project will deliver:

- a new three-storey building
- new innovative learning environments
- 14 permanent teaching spaces
- upgrades to core facilities
- a new library
- more functional open outdoor play space.

Progress summary

The upgrade of West Ryde Public School is progressing well with the substructure works nearing completion.

Next steps

- the contractor will be preparing the ground floor slab
- construction of the concrete frame for the new teaching block will commence.

Safety

The safety of the school community and neighbours is of the highest priority.

Throughout construction, a dedicated entrance will be used by the contractor, with all vehicles entering and exiting via Endeavor Street. The delivery of construction materials and equipment will be scheduled outside of school drop-off and pickup times.

The work is being completed under an Environmental Management Plan, which includes strategies for managing noise, dust, air quality and hazardous materials.

Work updates will continue to be provided throughout the construction period.
