Removal of asbestos containing material at West Ryde Public School continuing

After the removal of asbestos containing material from the West Ryde Public School upgrade site was completed on 11 May, tests have confirmed that additional material contains bonded Asbestos (Asbestos that is not air borne).

Asbestos is managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and Safe Work NSW by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists and occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines. Appropriate safety measures will be implemented prior to removal.

A remediation plan has been developed and removal of the asbestos containing material is planned to be carried out in one day on Saturday 25 May.

The health, safety and well-being of students, staff and neighbours is our highest priority. Air monitoring and site fencing will remain in place until further notice and we will continue to keep the community updated as more information becomes available.

The removal of asbestos containing material will not pose a risk to the local community.
