

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

West Ryde Public School

A project is underway to upgrade West Ryde Public School. The project will provide new facilities for students and staff. Once completed in mid-2020, the project will deliver:

- A new three-storey building
- New innovative learning environments
- 14 permanent teaching spaces
- Upgrades to core facilities
- A new library
- More functional open outdoor play space.

Progress summary

The works are progressing well with the structural concrete works complete and the roof works having started.

Summer school holiday works

Works taking place over the holiday period will include roofing, facades and internal fit out. Works will only occur during council approved hours from Monday to Saturday between 7:00am and 5:00pm.

A Site Manager and Safety Officer will be onsite during the period to ensure that the works are managed effectively.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Works taking place over the holiday period will include roofing, facades and internal fit out.

What are the construction working hours?

Works will only occur during council approved hours from Monday to Saturday between 7:00am and 5:00pm.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Works will continue throughout the period, however no work will take place on public holidays or Sundays.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Hoarding and shade cloth has been erected around the perimeter of the site. Noise and dust controls are in place to minimise the impacts on the local community.

How will traffic be managed?

Licenced traffic controllers are onsite to conduct the safety management of traffic and pedestrians.
