Since the opening of the new building, refurbishment of the existing ground floor administration building (Block A) has commenced.

Over the Term 2 break, we will be completing work on the administration building and commence the final stage of the project, which will include landscaping work, removal of all demountables and improvements to the play area.

We will ensure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and disruptions are minimised. Our contractors will ensure their teams comply with social distancing restrictions to ensure a safe workplace.

### What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the Term 2 holidays will be as per the standard hours. Monday to Saturday: 7:00am to 5:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays.

### What safety measurements will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Site fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access / school access. A site manager and safety officer will supervise the site at all times.

### How will traffic be managed?

Traffic controllers will be onsite as required to ensure the safe management of traffic and pedestrians.
