Removal of possible asbestos containing material

A project is underway to upgrade West Ryde Public School which will provide new facilities for students and staff.

The ongoing planned works the school will require the removal of material from site, which may contain bonded asbestos. Bonded asbestos is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Hours of work

The material will be removed by a licensed asbestos removal contractor, and is scheduled to take place between Saturday 4 July and Saturday 18 July. Work will only take place on Saturdays between 7:00am and 5:00pm, weather permitting.

Safety measures in place

Safety measures have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community.

This material will be removed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines. Testing will be completed after the work to ensure the site is safe for students, staff and the community with a clearance certificate issued by a consultant hygienist.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the local community.
