Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Westfields Sports High School

A project is underway to upgrade Westfields Sports High School to cater for projected growth in the area. This upgrade includes:

- 23 new permanent learning spaces, including new facilities for teaching wood and metal technologies and science
- upgraded staff facilities
- removal of demountables

The new modern facilities contain flexible and innovative, technology rich teaching spaces which will create dynamic learning experiences for students and encourage collaboration.

Progress summary

Site establishment was completed in March in preparation for demolition. The project is expected to be completed late 2020.

Works update

Demolition works at Westfields Sports High School commenced in April and will continue for approximately five weeks. During this time Block J, site storage and bus sheds on site will be removed.

Construction work is scheduled to take place during the Term 1 school holidays. Works will take place between 7am and 5pm Monday to Friday, and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

The safety of the school community and neighbours is our highest priority. Hoarding and shade cloth has been installed to reduce noise and dust impacts.

Construction vehicle movement and deliveries will be scheduled outside peak school operation hours. Traffic management will be in place where required.
