The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Progress summary

Construction of the new preschool building on the grounds at Wilkins Public School is now finished and the school's basketball courts have been upgraded to multipurpose courts.

The Department of Education is continuing discussions with Inner West Council to determine the possibility of the council operating the new preschool facilities.

Next steps

The new building is ready for handover to the operator, once a new licence agreement is signed. Following this, the preschool operator will arrange a fitout of the new building before moving into their new facilities.

Upgrades to kindergarten classrooms

Once the new preschool is occupied, School Infrastructure NSW will refurbish the current preschool rooms into learning spaces for Wilkins Public School kindergarten.
