The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Progress summary

During the April 2021 school holidays works were undertaken to:

- install structural steel and wall framing
- lay stormwater pipes and connections
- complete earthworks to sports court.

Next steps

The procurement process for the tender for the lease and operation of the new preschool facilities will commence shortly.

Under the processes established by the Preschool licence terms and conditions, the Department of Education will commence discussions with Inner West Council (IWC) to determine the possibility of council operating the new preschool facilities.

The lease negotiation and assessment process will ascertain council's interest and ability to operate the lease.

Should council indicate they do not wish to negotiate the lease agreement, an open tender process will be undertaken.
