#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### Willoughby Public School upgrade

A project is underway at Willoughby Public School. The project will allow the school to accommodate 1,200 students in permanent facilities by providing:

- 20 permanent learning spaces
- a new special programs room
- new administration and staff facilities
- a new canteen and hall
- increased and improved outdoor play space, including a new multi-sports court.
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

#### Project update

The new building and refurbished Building D are now complete. To reduce disruption to school operations and learning, students and staff will move into the new and refurbished buildings progressively from next week.

All classrooms will be relocated after school hours. The day following relocation, children will move into the new classrooms under the instruction of their teacher and support staff.

New access arrangements will be in place for the school that will continue into Term 2. This includes a new school reception and administration area in place from next week, Monday 23 March 2020. In addition, the Rose Garden gates on Oakville Road will be closed from Week 11, Term 1. The following pages show the layout and access arrangements for the school during the last three weeks of Term 1 and from the start of Term 2, 2020.

This week the library, administration and some classrooms will move to the new building.


- Year 6 - Classes 6DS, 6O, 6C, 6L, 6/5R, 6/5H

This map shows the layout and access arrangements from Monday 23 March to Friday 3 April 2020:




## From Monday 6 April 2020 to Thursday 9 April 2020
