Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Our work to deliver new and upgraded schools for New South Wales is essential to the future learning needs of our students. We will continue working to deliver these important projects.

Willoughby Public School

We are upgrading Willoughby Public School to accommodate 1,200 students in new or refurbished facilities including:

- 20 new flexible learning spaces
- special programs rooms
- administration and staff facilities
- a canteen and hall
- increased and improved outdoor play space, including a new multi-sports court
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

Progress summary

We have completed work on the new building with 20 flexible learning spaces, a hall, library and administration and staff facilities. We have also refurbished classrooms inside an existing building.

School holiday works

A new school reception area and access gate is now open on Oakville Road in front of the new building. Existing access gates on Oakville Road will be closed from Monday 6 April 2020.

From Monday 6 April 2020, we will:

- refurbish classrooms inside two existing buildings
- continue landscaping
- build a new amenities block and canteen
- work on the new court and COLA.

Work hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am to 12:00pm Saturdays.

We will continue to update you on the school upgrade as it progresses.
