The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Construction has begun on the Wilton Public School upgrade which includes:

- 22 new permanent flexible learning spaces including additional support units
- upgraded core facilities including the hall, administration, library, canteen, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), and covered walkway
- a new car park area.

Progress summary

Work is continuing on Block J, the new two-storey learning block with concrete slab and foundation work ongoing throughout Term 2. Additionally, work to build a stormwater tank and the electrical service connection will continue over the next few weeks.

Construction works have been approved to occur between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00 am to 1:00 pm, Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.

Traffic management during the work

Traffic control will be in place as required to manage pedestrian and vehicular movements near the construction site access points. Should there need to be any changes to this access in and around the site, we will let you know ahead of the work.

Noise and dust control measures during the work

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements, including the spreading of road base onto soil areas to suppress dust. Dust from construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Trucks entering and leaving the site will cover their loads.
