Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Progress overview

Early planning for a new primary school in Wilton Junction is now complete. It is anticipated the new primary school in Wilton Junction will include:

- New permanent, fit-for-purpose classrooms and open spaces
- Core facilities such as a new library, hall and a covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- New administration and staff areas
- New support learning classrooms.

The master plan has been developed providing a basic layout of the new school. Please note the scope is indicative and subject to change pending approvals and the next stages of design and planning.

A Project Control Group (PCG) has been established and includes representatives from the NSW Department of Education, School Community Group (SCG) leadership, and design professionals. The purpose of the PCG is to assist in the development of the project's scope of work to ensure that it aligns with the needs of the community now and into the future.

Consultants and the design team will continue to work on the detailed planning in preparation for the upcoming delivery phases. This will involve consideration of education requirements, traffic and transport links and possible shared area opportunities.
