Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Progress summary

A project is underway at Wollongong Public School to provide 10 flexible learning spaces, refurbished administration facilities, refurbished amenities, and a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

Current work includes a concrete pour on Level One and completion of concrete columns from Level One to the roof. Installation of structural steel on the Ground Floor is finalised, and progressing on Level One. Internal and external framing of the Ground Floor has started.

Summer school holiday works

Over the summer holidays, the new learning building works will be progressed; Ground Floor fit out works will be underway and service installation on the first floor will progress.

External landscaping works will also be underway including the construction of an access ramp to the rear of the existing canteen area.

Summer school holiday works

Site work will cease at close of business on 24 December 2019 and will resume on 2 January 2020. Work hours are in line with council requirements.

In line with our Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Traffic control and security measures will also be in place where required for the safety of the community.

We are here to make sure this work is carried out safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure disruptions are minimised to the wider community.

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Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Learning building works will be progressed, Ground Floor fit out works will be underway and Level One services rough-in and sheeting will be progressing.

External landscaping works will also be underway including the construction of an access ramp to the rear of the existing canteen area.

What are the construction working hours?

Works hours will be from 7.00am to 5.00pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Site work will cease at close of business on 24 December 2019 and will resume on 2 January 2020. Work hours are in line with council requirements.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been installed around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

In line with the Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Dust will be controlled by spraying water during earth works whenever permissible under water-use restrictions

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
