# Upgrading facilities at Wollumbin High School

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

A program of work is being delivered at Wollumbin High School to provide improved facilities for students and staff. The upgrade will include:



Redevelopment of Blocks H and R to provide 3 classrooms and facilities for students with additional learning or support needs



Redevelopment of classrooms on the ground floor of Block G for music




Refurbishment of student toilets on the lower level of Block A



Exterior painting, improved stormwater drainage, new football goal posts, and renovation of the sports court



New energy efficient LED lighting, ventilation and cooling upgrades

# Schedule of works

While the Wollumbin High School site has been in use by the Murwillumbah Learning Community High School, work has been limited to minimise disruption to learning. This time has been used to undertake some maintenance activities, which will continue during the school holidays, and to plan the upgrade works.

To minimise disruption and provide a single point of contact for the school, most of the refurbishment works are being packaged together into one building contract. It is expected that a contract will be awarded in early 2025 with work to begin shortly after. The timeline will be confirmed once a building contractor has been engaged.

### Completed

#### Maintenance

Maintenance tasks completed so far during 2024 include:

- Reinstatement of the retaining wall outside the hall which was damaged due to stormwater
- Installation of a new school security camera system
- Re-fencing of the school sports court

#### Underway

#### Planning and design

Planning currently underway includes:

- Finalising the design of new music classrooms
- Finalising the design of the new facilities for specialist support classes
- Hydrological assessments and engineering design for stormwater improvements
- Scoping and planning for lighting and ventilation upgrades
- Preparing to issue a request for tenders

## School holidays

#### Early works

During the school holiday period work at the school will include:

- Refurbishment of student toilets on the lower floor of Block A
- Resurfacing and repainting the sports court
- New paint and carpet for some spaces across the site
- Installation of new football goal posts

### During 2025

#### Main works

#### Redeveloped spaces

Music spaces in Block G will be created first, followed by new support unit spaces. To avoid disruption, support classes will stay where they are until the new facilities are ready.

#### Removal of temporary buildings

Once students and teachers move to the new support unit facilities, temporary buildings will be removed and the area, including athletics facilities, will be reinstated.

#### Other works

Including lighting and cooling, exterior painting and minor landscaping improvements.
