We are excited to announce the Yagoona Public School upgrade has been completed. The project has delivered a new two-storey building with 16 permanent classrooms, toilet facilities, an administration facility and new landscaped areas.

Will there be any changes to staff parking or the Kiss and Drop zone?

When will the demountable classrooms be removed?
