Yagoona Public School Project update

February 2019

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Yagoona Public School

A project is underway at Yagoona Public School. The project will provide:

- 16 new permanent classrooms
- associated toilets
- a new administration building on the ground floor of the new classroom block.

Progress summary

The construction contract has been awarded to Taylor Construction. Site establishment activities have been undertaken including the installation of shade cloth and hoarding as well as demountable classrooms. The Development Application has been approved. The final design is also underway.

Next steps

Main construction work is planned to commence in early 2019. Construction will take place between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and between 8am and 4pm on Saturdays.

To reduce the impact of traffic and parking, workers will be advised to park in a vicinity which reduces impacts on the school community. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of drop-off and pick-up times where possible.
