The NSW Government's 2018/19 Budget includes \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. A further \$160 million has also been invested as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Yagoona Public School

A project is underway at Yagoona Public School. The project will provide:

- 16 new permanent classrooms
- Associated toilets
- A new administration building on the ground floor of the new classroom block.

Progress summary

The Development Application has been approved and the construction contract has been awarded. The final design is underway.

Next steps

Site establishment will prepares the area so that construction can begin. We will install shade cloth and hoarding on the site and by demountables shortly thereafter.

To minimise traffic and parking impacts, workers will park away from the school and deliveries will be scheduled outside of dropoff and pick-up times where possible.

Construction will take place between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and between 8am and 4pm on Saturdays.
