Works Notification | 19 June 2023

The NSW Department of Education is constructing new boarding facilities and upgrading existing boarding facilities to deliver enhanced learning outcomes for students through improved accommodation.

Work to begin on new boarding facilities

Site establishment for the construction of the new boarding facilities will start Monday 26 June 2023. Trucks and equipment will arrive on site and machinery equipment will be stored in compounds within the fenced area (see map overleaf).

The upcoming works will consist of making the ground ready for construction which includes:

- starting the structural piling work
- digging trenches that will hold the cables that will carry electricity and internet services to the site
 as well as the pipes that will make up the drainage and water services to the new boarding facilities
- building the footings for the new boarding facilities which includes pouring concrete inside steel structures built inside trenches throughout the site.

Mason Building works from 1 July 2023

Students boarding in the Mason Building will be asked to pack their belongings in moving boxes provided by Zauner Construction week starting 26 June 2023, the last week of Term 2, to prepare for works in the building during the winter school break. During this time student belongings will be securely stored in the Mason Building away from the rooms that will be refurbished.

The minor refurbishment works at the Mason Building will be completed by 14 July 2023.

Management of construction impacts

There will be no changes to the established construction zone as notified in our Project Update shared in May 2023.

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times and deliveries will be scheduled to occur during school hours where possible.

Machinery such as excavators and bulldozers will be used and works may be noisy at times. We are working closely with the Principal to minimise impacts on school operations and have negotiated the working hours outlined overleaf.

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




Working hours
