Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

An upgrade is underway for a new multipurpose hall at Yass High School. The hall will include a basketball court, stage, storage and amenities.

Progress summary

Since December 2021, contractors have established the construction site by installing fencing, shade cloth, and sheds. They have also removed and mulched four trees, deconstructed the covered outdoor learning area (COLA), and demolished the concrete slab.

Next steps

In the coming weeks contractors will begin bulk earthworks; start to fill, grade, and compact the building pad site; then prepare to install footings.
