Young High School upgrade and joint use library and community facility

Project update | May 2023

Project overview

A major upgrade is underway at Young High School. The project will deliver a new joint use library and community facility, funded under a partnership between Hilltops Council and the NSW Department of Education, and additional upgrade works to the school by School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW).

Progress summary

We are close to finishing work on the new joint use library and community facility. The builder has finished installing the external cladding, most of the work on the building's interior, and has made good progress on the library car park.

Next steps

The next steps for the project are to finish all remaining external works, including the car park and footpaths, lighting, and landscaping in Carrington Park. We will also install AV equipment and furniture in the library.

We will work with Young High School and Hilltops Council to support their move into the new facilities and will provide an update once we have a confirmed date for the library opening.

Construction hours

The standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday. No works will take place on Sunday or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

Measures to control noise and dust

Flexshield noise barrier curtains will be placed along the TAFE early childhood facility fence and around any noise generating works. Shade cloth will be used to reduce dust impacts on the school and its neighbours. Dust from construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Trucks entering and leaving the site will cover their loads and be washed down to prevent transporting dust and mud from the site.
