Young High School upgrade and joint use library and community facility

Works notification

9 May 2022

Work is underway at Young High School to deliver a new joint use library and community facility, new learning spaces and general upgrades to school facilities.

Upcoming works include a concrete pour for the new library building, and landscaping and improvements to pedestrian walkways in Carrington Park to increase accessibility.

Concrete pour for the new joint use library

Works to pour the concrete slab for the upper ground floor of the new library building will take place on Wednesday 18 May 2022, weather permitting. In the event of wet weather, works may be postponed.

During the works, there will be an increase in truck movements to support the pouring of the slab. Trucks will enter and exit the site via Campbell Street. Traffic controllers will be in place to manage traffic flow and ensure pedestrian safety.

There will be limited access to Young High School via the Campbell Street entrance for the duration of the works. Students and staff are encouraged to use the entrance on Berthong Street.

Due to the complex nature of concrete pours, it is possible that work may need to continue beyond the standard construction hours for the project. We will ensure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and we will minimise the impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Landscaping and replacing paths in Carrington Park

Works in Carrington Park will involve replacing existing paths, installing new light posts, adding turf and seeding the surrounding area.

The works will take place from Monday 23 May to Monday 18 July 2022, weather permitting. In the event of wet weather, the works may be postponed or extended.

To ensure the safety of the community, the area for the works will be fenced off. Community members will still be able to access the rest of the park.

Frequently asked questions

What are the construction hours for the project?

The standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday. No works will take place on Sunday or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts of construction works?

Flexshield noise barrier curtains will be placed along the TAFE early childhood facility fence and around any noise generating works.

Shade cloth will be used to reduce dust impacts on the school and its neighbours. Dust from construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Trucks entering and leaving the site will cover their loads and be washed down to prevent tracking dust and mud from the site
