Flood remediation works complete | October 2023

The recent investment in our school with both flood remediation and planned maintenance funds has significantly improved our school. Many of our buildings have been remediated and modernised. We have a stunning newly refurbished library with inspiring and modern resources complete with a fabulous interior design. The Kindergarten classroom has been fitted with modern furniture and contemporary fittings, to create inspiring learning spaces. Our new turfed quadrangle looks fantastic and is already proving a very popular teaching and learning space. We have upgraded toilets, hallways, playgrounds and sports fields. The new General Assistant shed is above the 2022 flood level and provides far greater space and flexibility.

Remediation is now complete

The administration building has been stripped out, renovated, and refurbished with modern furniture, fittings, kitchen, and IT infrastructure. The ground level kindergarten classroom, K1, has been stripped out and refitted with new creative furniture and learning spaces. The canteen has a clean new design, fresh flooring, and fittings. Other works include new flooring to the hall, refurbished toilet facilities, a new General Assistant's shed, remediated playground and sports facilities, landscaping, and underside linings to two COLAs for amenity and increased acoustic performance.

Modernised Library

The library and music room have been refitted with a new roof, ceilings, internal walls, and floor coverings. The spacious high vaulted ceiling has been repainted and fitted with new lighting. The library has been modernised with the latest design standards for furniture and arrangement for groups and private study, and innovative contemporary learning resources. The music room has new acoustic walls, furniture, carpet, and new instruments. Both facilities open onto the remediated and recently installed soft fall playground.
