Tumbulgum Public School Project update | September 2023

What is happening at Tumbulgum Public School?

A project is underway to refurbish Tumbulgum Public School after it was damaged by floods in early 2022. Students will remain in their temporary demountable school until the refurbishment is complete.

Current status

• Sections of the flood damaged school have been demolished and stripped out as outlined in the Works Notice from August 2023. The demolition works will be completed by mid-September 2023.

Next steps

- A tender for the design of the refurbishment works will be closed in September 2023 and the school will be advised of the schedule/s once that has been finalised.
- An information session will be held later in 2023 to review the designs for the refurbishment.
- Students will move into their refurbished school at Tumbulgum Public School by mid 2024.

Future plans to rebuild Tumbulgum Public School will progress in consultation with the Northern Rivers Reconstruction Corporation, Tweed Shire Council and the SES.
