## Project update | September 2023

### What is happening at Wardell Public School?

A project is underway to rebuild Wardell Public School after it was damaged by floods in early 2022. The project will deliver new modern and flexible learning environments and core facilities that will support the long-term needs of the local community. Students will continue learning from temporary demountable classrooms at Wardell Public School while the school is being rebuilt.

### Current Status

- The master planning and concept design phases are complete.
- An information session was held on 16 August 2023 whereby the project team were on hand to answer questions and artist impressions were on display of the new school.
