Condong Public School Project update | May 2023

What is happening at Condong Public School?

A project is underway to rebuild Condong Public School after it was damaged by floods in early 2022. In the interim, students will remain learning at the former Murwillumbah South Infants School.

Current status

- Condong Public School is considered a high flood evacuation risk by the SES and Tweed Shire Council have expressed concerns about a new school being built on the existing site.
- Due to the high level of planning risk, Condong Public School will remain at the former Murwillumbah South Infants School, in the interim. The school will have refurbishment works undertaken to improve the learning and play spaces.
- Work will be undertaken with the Department of Transport to improve support to the school, in this interim phase.

Next steps

• SINSW Asset Management Unit (AMU) will commence the scope and schedule for refurbishment works at former Murwillumbah South Infants School site.

A commitment to rebuild Condong Public School in the long term remains. SINSW continues to seek advice from the NRRC relating to the rollout of their various housing program strategies to ensure our school infrastructure meet the long-term needs of the community, the SES and Tweed Shire Council.
