Dear parents and carers


The building of the temporary school at Lismore South Public School has been completed. The school includes classrooms, administration areas, school library, canteen and OSHC buildings as well as separate spaces for the Preschool students and staff.

School staff are preparing classrooms and spaces in the new rooms during Week 1 so that K-6 students can return to Lismore South in Week 2 of Term 4. Some work may continue on the school grounds during the term, as the staff and students settle into their new spaces.

Pre-school staff and students will move to their new spaces at Lismore South Public School as soon as the Federal Government grants the license needed to operate from the new venue. Until then, pre-school children will continue to learn from Goonellabah Public School.


