Crabbes Creek Public School Works notification

The NSW Department of Education is coordinating an emergency response effort that is unprecedented in terms of scale and impact. A large number of schools in the Northern Rivers region have damage to either the entire site or some buildings and facilities.

What is happening at Crabbes Creek Public School?

Most of the buildings at Crabbes Creek were inundated with flood waters, however there has been no structural damage. The school is currently closed for cleaning and remediation.

Students are currently learning at Brunswick Heads Public school.

A temporary 'pop-up' school is being installed on the Crabbes Creek Public School school car park so students can return to their usual site as soon as possible.

Work is underway to complete installation of the temporary buildings that are now onsite at the school so they can be used by students.

.A timeline on remediation of the existing buildings will be provided in early Term 2

Day 1 Term 2

From Day 1 Term 2 students will no longer be learning at Brunswick Heads Public School and will resume learning in temporary demountable accommodation at Crabbes Creek Public School.

Hours of work

Works will be completed between the hours of 7am-5pm Monday to Saturdays, with no work on public holidays or Sundays.

We are here to make sure that the works are completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

What else is happening in the region

The School Infrastructure regional office has inspected all schools in flood impacted areas. We continue to work with emergency response organisations to remove rubbish, clean and secure affected sites.

Many school sites have been able to resume operating, while some students have been relocated to alternative sites so that their learning can continue. Our current priority is to source, deliver, install and handover temporary buildings to accommodate displaced students. The timing of all work and handover of temporary spaces is subject to local weather conditions.
