# Main Arm Upper Public School Works notification

The NSW Department of Education is coordinating an emergency response effort that is unprecedented in terms of scale and impact. A large number of schools in the Northern Rivers region have damage to either the entire site or some buildings and facilities.

### What is happening at Main Arm Upper Public School?

The Main Arm Upper Public School site was significantly damaged by flood waters and is currently closed.

Students are currently learning at Durrumbul Public School while a temporary 'pop-up' school is established on the Main Arm Upper Public School grounds.

#### Day 1 Term 2

Students from Main Arm Upper Public School will continue learning from Durrumbul Public School from Day 1 in Term 2.

It is forecast that the installation of temporary demountable classrooms at Main Arm Upper Public School will be completed in early Term 2, which will allow students to resume learning at their regular school site location.

School Infrastructure NSW is working to have students resume learning at the Main Arm Upper Public School site as quickly as possible and will provide an update on the timelines of this in early Term 2.

#### Hours of work

Works will be completed between the hours of 7am-5pm Monday to Saturdays, with no work on public holidays or Sundays.

We are here to make sure that the works are completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

#### What else is happening in the region

The School Infrastructure regional office has inspected all schools in flood impacted areas. We continue to work with emergency response organisations to remove rubbish, clean and secure affected sites.

Many school sites have been able to resume operating, while some students have been relocated to alternative sites so that their learning can continue. Our current priority is to source, deliver, install and handover temporary buildings to accommodate displaced students. The timing of all work and handover of temporary spaces is subject to local weather conditions.
