Wyrallah Road Public School Works Notification

A project is underway to repair and remediate flood-damaged buildings and equipment at Wyrallah Road Public School.

Remediation activities

As part of the flood recovery project, works will occur during the school holidays (weather permitting).

From Monday 26 September the following work will be undertaken:

- establish site compound for future construction of the new sports court
- fence line vegetation clearing. Fifteen trees will be removed along the storm water fence line to make way for the new games court. The Lismore Council Tree Officer has inspected the trees and granted approval under Lismore Local Environmental Plan 2012 and Lismore Development Control Plan.

Work hours will be Monday to Friday, from 7am to 4pm.

Site access will be via Nielson Street. The site compound will be fenced off and out of bounds to students and staff when they return in Term 4.

Thirty Koala friendly and other Council approved local native trees will be replanted along the storm water drain and in adjacent school grounds. This is in line with Wyrallah Road Public School's ongoing support for Friends of Koalas by providing food and habitat trees for local koalas.

The health, safety and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
