

# Adamstown Public School

## Works notification

10 October 2022

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During the school holidays, the electrical switchboard in Block B at Adamstown Public School was replaced. These planned maintenance works included working with asbestos containing material located in the backing board of the switchboard.

Safety measures and monitoring were in place. The area was cordoned off before works started and remained out of bounds until the removal and associated maintenance work was completed.

The area was remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Work took place on Tuesday 27 September 2022. All asbestos containing material was removed in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

Testing was completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school has received a clearance certificate and the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
