Works notification | 3 April 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We have replaced a broken window in a meeting room in the Administrative Building at Adamstown Public School. This involved working with suspected asbestos containing material in the window frame.

As a precaution, the room was isolated from students and staff on 18 March 2024, and air monitoring was put in place until testing could be done.

An independent hygienist was engaged who undertook testing. Results revealed the material in the window frame tested negative to asbestos.

Work to replace the window glass was conducted on 22 March 2024 and the room was reopened for use.
