Dear parents, carers and staff

A section of the computer room wall was damaged while moving furniture in the Building A computer room on Thursday 7 November 2024.

As a precaution, work stopped immediately as the school's general assistant suspected the mall may contain asbestos and be coated with lead-based paint.

Access to the room, which is not listed in the school's asbestos register, was restricted.

Classes have been temporarily moved to other areas of the school while the room is out of use.

NSW Health explains living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.

An independent hygienist visited after school hours on Friday 8 November to remove the section of the wall and conduct testing.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place while work is done.

Once the work is complete, the hygienist will inspect the area to ensure it has been remediated.

The room will only be reopened after the hygienist issues a clearance certificate.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep the community updated.
