Works notification | 29 October 2024

Dear parents, carers and staff

A LED light located outside Building C at Albion Park Public School was found dislodged from an eave sheet, known to contain asbestos, on Tuesday 22 October 2024.

NSW Health explains living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.

An independent hygienist inspected the area the same day and the light and eave sheet – which was listed in the school's asbestos register – were sealed.

Work to replace both items took place outside of school hours on Saturday 26 October.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures, including air monitoring, was in place while work was done.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The area has been inspected by an independent hygienist and a clearance certificate has been issued to confirm it has been fully remediated.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep the community updated.
